

PROTEST

We, the owners of the subject property protest LADWP's Rate Proposed Restructuring and Increase. Our written protest is based on LADWP's reasons for a need for the rate increase as follows:

1. "Investing in infrastructure to provide reliable water".

Water supply at the current high rate is more than reliable. Investing to replace the old infrastructure requires identification of each specific portion(s) and the cost estimate of each individual project(s) proposed for separate voting and approval. The proposed rate increase to invest in replacing, even a portion of the old infrastructure is hollow written words designed to collect revenues that will be used for other reasons.

2. "Transforming water supply by encouraging conservation".

Promoting Water Conservation at the current high Billing Rate is very effective and shows outstanding results. New revenue to be collected under the proposed rate increases will be channeled to LADWP Executives', and High Level Employees compensations!.

3. "Expanding Water Supply Projects".

Expanding unspecified local water supply projects, under the proposed rate increases, is a false statement lacking any technical merit. Each individual project has its detailed technical and cost estimate that requires separate voting and approval .

4. "Reducing reliance on expensive imported purchased water"

If the current level of purchased expensive imported water under the current billing rate is high, the amount of purchased water reduced under the imposed conservation will not need more revenue. The new revenue that will be collected under the proposed rate increases will be channeled to Executives and High Level employees compensation!.

5. "Meeting Regulatory Mandates Concerning Drinking Water Quality".

Los Angeles County 2014-2015 Property General Tax Levy for all Agencies, including LADWP, is assessed at \$5,465.82 (%100) for the subject property. Voted Indebtedness for the city of Los Angeles is \$153.57, and Metro Water District is \$19.13. Direct Assessment for LA Maintenance is \$119.14, and LA Stormwater is \$50.40. In addition the Los Angeles County had proposed to collect with the Property Tax \$83.00 Clean Water Fee, beginning 2013-2014 Property Tax Roll. The voting results for that proposal is not known!. All those tax revenues are collected for the city of Los Angeles and its LADWP Agency to provide adequate water supply of quality that meets the regulatory mandates. The extra revenue to be collected under the proposed rate increase will constitute heavy burden on Los Angeles City' Utilities Users.

It should be noted the excessive Electric and Water charges, and Sewer charges billed by LADWP for the Department of sanitation for the subject property; were disputed and documented for the years 2000, 2001, 2009, 2010, and 2014. The Department of Water and Power and its excusive possess a bag full of tricks designed to collect increased revenue when needed from one billing cycle to the other. Those ticks consists of either/or all of the following practices (see the attached 20014 billing charges Exhibit):

- 1. Eclectic KWH usage, and Water and Sewer HCF usage increases from one billing cycle to the other for the same number of users .**
- 2. Tier 1 and Tier 2 electric KWH and water HCF, its and dollars rates increase from one billing cycle to the other.**
- 3. The total billed charges increases form one billing cycle to the other for the same number of users.**

We do not believe that the City Councils have approved such unprofessional practice. We, respectfully urges the City Councils to disapprove LADWP's Excessive Rate plan Increases for the coming future years.




