DISCUSSION

The donation is for the benefit of Emergency Services Division and the Los Angeles Police Department (Department). The off-lead vapor wake detection canine will replace the recently retired K9 Riddick, which was the Department's only certified off-lead canine. An off-lead canine has the ability to search for explosive odor from a remote distance adding another layer of safety for the handler. The service dog being donated will also be trained in vapor wake detection. With the addition of this canine, the Department will field the first and only off-lead vapor wake detection dog in California. Veterinarian costs and dog food will be provided by the Department.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Los Angeles Police Department patents.

Administrative Services Bureau has reviewed the donation and determined that it has been submitted in accordance with Section 5.467 et seq. of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, which provides for the receipt and acceptance of donations to the Los Angeles Police Department.



Parker Los Angeles Police Foundation. The funds will be used to purchase an off-lead/vapor wake explosive detection canine from Wynfield Kennels. The donation was provisionally received on January 20, 2016. The contact person for the Foundation is Senior Clerk Typist Regina Menez, Serial No. E9306, (213) 847-1226.


The donation will benefit the Department and the Bomb Squad by allowing the replacement of K9 Riddick who was recently retired from service due to cancer. Riddick was the only certified off-lead canine assigned to the Department and his retirement has left an operational void in the Bomb Squad. An off-lead canine has the ability to search for explosive odor from a remote distance adding another layer of safety for the handler. The new canine will also be trained in vapor wake detection as well. With the addition of this canine, the Department will field the first and only off-lead/vapor wake canine in California.

The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation, and, the donor is not allowed the use of any Los Angeles Police Department patent.
