DISCUSSION

The donation is for the benefit of the Los Angeles Police Department (Department) and the community it serves. The Department is implementing the RMS to modernize aging mainframe systems and applications in support of the Connected Officer Program. This will be the largest and most complex component of the Department's modernization effort, as this system houses all operational data and will affect nearly every aspect of the Department. The donation includes more servers and more storage. Remaining funds will be used for a support upgrade of the existing storage array. The RMS will also allow officers in the field to be connected via mobile field reporting and mobile applications for the collection and delivery of data to support officer safety and situational awareness. The RMS will increase the overall efficiency and speed of the services the Department provides to the community.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Department patents.

Administrative Services Bureau has reviewed the donation and determined that it has been submitted in accordance with Section 5.467 et seq. of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, which provides for the receipt and acceptance of donations to the Department.

The Los Angeles Police Department is implementing a Records Management System (RMS), the objective of which is to modernize and/or replace aging mainframe systems and applications in support of the Connected Officer Program. The RMS is the largest and most complex component of LAPD's modernization effort, as it houses all operational data (crime, arrest, booking, property, evidence, jail, etc.). The RMS will affect nearly every aspect of the Department and has the greatest potential for creating truly transformational changes to how the LAPD leverages technology to do business. The RMS will serve as the foundational infrastructure to enable the connected officer via mobile field reporting and mobile applications for the collection of data in the field and the delivery of the right data to officers in the field, at the right time, to support officer safety, situational awareness, and, ultimately, better service to the community.

This grant application specifically requests the funding for the on premise hardware (servers and storage) required to support the new RMS application and data. The project in its entirety for all phases of implementation will cost \$13 M over three years.

**If yes, please list the most recent date of submission and the result:** The initial expenses for the RMS software and implementation will be covered by a \$3 M grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety. The LAPD has requested funding from the City's General Fund for Fiscal Year '17-'18 to implement the second phase of the project. The 17-18 budget will be reviewed the CAO, Mayor's Office and City Council over the next few months, and the final budget will be published in May 2017.

**If no, please explain the reason why it was not submitted:** N/A

**What objectives will be accomplished if the funding is granted?**

The Department will be able to procure and install the hardware platform on which the RMS is to be installed.

**How many officers will be impacted with this grant?**

The entire sworn and civilian workforce – over 12,000 people.

**How will the community be impacted by this grant?**

The RMS will provide increased transparency to the community the Department serves and protects (including better processing of CA Public Records Act requests), and greatly enhance the efficiency and speed of the services it provides. It will also provide for increases in officer safety and productivity via mobile technology under the Connected Officer Program and improved reporting.

**Describe the short term outcome and long term impact you anticipate within the Department and in the community it serves as result of this grant.**

**Short term:** Implement the system for the Custody Services and Traffic Divisions. This will allow for more accurate, safer, and more efficient inmate intake, housing, cell checks, and release. Traffic Collision reports will be available to the community members involved much sooner and with greater accuracy than possible through existing processes.  
**Long-term:** Entire LAPD technology infrastructure to be transformed resulting in better service to the community due to force multiplication achieved through more efficient officer business processes.


