DISCUSSION

The donation is for the benefit of the Los Angeles Police Department (Department). The donated items are foam-filled neoprene tubes designed to fill the gap between the front seats of a vehicle and the center console to prevent loose objects from falling under the seats. If approved, the donation will be used to install 5,600 of these devices into 2,800 black and white vehicles with the purpose of reducing distracted driving and increasing driver awareness and safety. Director of Police Transportation, George Yamanaka, Motor Transport Division, has determined there would be no adverse issues associated with the installation of these devices. There are no maintenance or administrative costs associated with this donation. Risk Management Division has a restricted account with the Los Angeles Police Foundation (Foundation). The Foundation will use funds from this account to pay for the items.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Department patents.

Administrative Services Bureau has reviewed the donation and determined that it has been submitted in accordance with Section 5.467 et seq. of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, which provides for the receipt and acceptance of donations to the Department.
