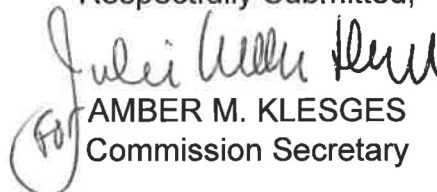
SUBJECT: RESOLUTION NO. 16-7892 – PROPOSED SECOND AMENDMENT TO  
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT NO. 11-2997 WITH SA RECYCLING, LLC.

Pursuant to Section 606 of the City Charter, enclosed for your approval is proposed Second Amendment Agreement No. 16-2997-B between the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department and SA Recycling LLC, which was approved at the January 7, 2016 meeting of the Board of Harbor Commissioners.
