Hello.

My name is Natalie Nichols, and I live at 2249 Laurel Canyon Blvd. with my partner, Don Waller, who is the homeowner. I am writing to express our support for the motion to require public notice when new streets are built in this neighborhood (ref Council File Number 16-0421). My understanding is that the tracks referred to as "paper streets" (because they only exist on paper) require the issuance of a B Permit, which currently can be done by the City without any notice whatsoever. We have one of these paper streets running behind our house (Oakden Drive), so naturally this is a potential concern for us. We also understand that some Canyon neighbors have already suffered as a result of developers building or attempting to build such streets.
