Van Nuys Airport (VNY) has experienced three separate security incidents of unauthorized entry since late December. On April 2, 2016 at 9:20 p.m. a person climbed the fence at Van Nuys Airport and caused more than \$10,000 in damages to two planes and a car. One of the planes had vital components broken off and scattered on the tarmac.

The first incident in December involved a person spray painting airplanes on airport grounds. The second incident in March involved a man crashing his vehicle through the airport fence, driving across the tarmac and crashing into a plane.

Van Nuys Airport is one of the world's busiest general aviation airports and serves an important role in enhancing the safety and efficiency at the region's commercial airports. Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) must maintain the integrity of the security perimeter to ensure the safe operation of Van Nuys Airport.

I THEREFORE MOVE that LAWA report back on the recent security issues at Van Nuys Airport, including the outcomes of the investigations into the three recent security incidents and a corrective action plan.
