Dear Council Member Bonin, Mayor Garcetti and Honorable City Council Leaders

We are strongly opposed to the Venice Business Improvement District and ask you to please vote No and stop the BID as it stands.

We ask this as for the last 28 years we have owned a 5 Unit Rent Controlled apartment building at 1411 Innes Place in Venice and we have been assessed by the BID without any prior notice \$3662.56 plus an additional 5% compounded every year after five years.

If the BID passes, within the present boundaries, in 5 years the amount will grow to \$4451.85 and keep climbing ever more every year. but we cannot recoup this amount as we can only raise rents by 3% every year. We have been placed within the boundaries of the BID but actually are prevented by housing laws from benefitting financially. We are housing providers, and have different laws to which we are beholden. We have been assessed but cannot benefit financially from being included in the BID. We wish to be removed.

A BID is usually formed to attract consumers to the area in which the BID operates so that their businesses prosper. These businesses pay for the services a BID provides. We have nothing to sell, our building is always full, but nevertheless we have been assessed.

We provide off street parking for 9 cars and a private patio with shade trees, a laundry room and bike parking but we are being assessed on the space these amenities take as if it was empty space on the Boardwalk available for business! Being housing providers we cannot benefit financially from a Business Improvement District as we do not have any more housing stock to "sell". Being in a rent control building tenants tend to stay for many years.

Innes Place is a quiet, 3 block residential street, with just 1 studio with an artist in residence, and yet we have been placed inside the BID and in Zone 1, an area that has "Higher Special Needs", the same zone as the Board Walk! There are no attractions or businesses on Innes Place so do not understand why we are in the assessment area and have been allocated to this zone. Unless of course to subsidize those that will benefit, legitimate merchants and business owners

Even though our property is zoned Commercial preserving existing housing stock in LA is a priority so it is unlikely that permits would ever be given to convert our building into a retail business.

We are Commercial in name only. We would like to be re zoned to Residential if that is the reason we are being assessed.

We are not developers, we have just this one building which we have always managed ourselves and upon which income we rely.

We take pride in providing a well cared for home for our tenants, but we are both retired, in our late 60s and 70's and we are very concerned about this very large assessment.

Most BIDS in other towns are funded by those that will benefit, the businesses, not peripheral residents that might even be negatively affected by a BID.

This BID needs more input from all concerned and open discussion on finding solutions for the homeless and transients in our neighborhood

We keep our property clean and well lit and do not need a BID to do these things for us

We consider the assessment of \$3662.56 per year to be punitive and would like to be removed from the BID should it pass.

Thank you for your time and consideration, please vote No on the BID as it stands, please listen to the many voices of the people and residents who oppose this.

RE: CF 16-0749(CD11) - NO B.I.D. FOR VENICE, CA

I am writing to oppose the establishment of a Business Improvement District in Venice. As a longtime stakeholder of Venice, I am concerned about both the Business Improvement District (BID) process and potential implementation.

I oppose for many reasons, including but not limited to:

1. The process for establishing the BID has not been public or transparent. It has not appeared on a Neighborhood Council agenda for comment or approval, and has only been on one Neighborhood Council committee agenda.
2. Very little detail or documents about the potential Venice BID have been made public.
3. Business Improvement Districts in the City of Los Angeles, and particularly their private security forces, have a history of hostility toward homeless and low-income residents resulting in several lawsuits since their inception in the late 1990s regarding unconstitutional practices.
4. Business Improvement Districts are a form of privatization that harms those that don't own property and limits democratic control over resources.
5. Business Improvement District assessments are not feasible for all businesses or property owners to pay, particularly non-profits and small business owners.
6. The founding premise for the Business Improvement District is at fault. It is claimed that a BID is needed because the City of Los Angeles is not providing the proper public services. While there is accuracy in the fact that the city is not providing services, the solution is not privatization. I vehemently oppose any

privatization of our public spaces and services. The city is responsible for providing the necessary budget to provide these services.

7. Currently, since 2011, global technology companies, such as Google and Snapchat, some of the richest companies on this planet, have enjoyed an 80% Tax Break – our money – taken out of our revenue stream – which isn't and should be invested into our public services. As a result of this Tax Break, "Championed" by Councilman Mike Bonin, the City of Los Angeles has lost Billions of Dollars in income. By making these companies pay their fair share, we will be able to properly fund our needed public services.

8. In 1904, Abbot Kinney deeded Ocean Front Walk to be a public park in perpetuity, which also included sharp restrictions on commerce; therefore the city has no authority to approve a Business Improvement District on this section of Venice.

For these and other reasons, we urge that any proposal for a BID in Venice be denied. Additionally, all documents regarding any plans to date for a BID should be released to the public.

And now all LA BIDs must report to the LAPD Police Commission as a result of too many use of force incidents! That's what you would be supporting.

The city owns a lot of property within this proposed gerrymandered BID and without the City kicking in more than 25% of the land and \$950,000 per year to privatize public space, the BID would not go forward. It is your responsibility to do the right thing and STOP the BID! LA County has a horrible reputation when it comes to siding with developers and internal corruption. Don't be a part of that.

The impact on Venice and the unintended consequences must be fully discussed because once the BID is established, it is almost impossible to disband it. VOTE NO in this BID!
