

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the proposed Sixth Amendment to Contract C-128057 with AAMCOM, LLC for operation and management of the Cityride Paratransit Program and Transit Technology Service Program.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the General Manager, Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), to execute the proposed Sixth Amendment to Contract C-128057 with AAMCOM, LLC for continued operation and management of the Cityride Paratransit Program and Transit Technology Service Program, through August 31, 2026, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that there is no General Fund impact. Sufficient funds exist within the City Proposition A Local Transit Assistance Fund to support the cost. The City's obligation is limited to the availability of appropriations.

Financial Policies Statement: The CAO also reports that the recommendation complies with City Financial Policies as sufficient appropriated funds exist to support the proposed expenditures.

Summary:

On November 12, 2025, your Transportation Committee considered an October 31, 2025 CAO report relative to the proposed Sixth Amendment to Contract C-128057 with AAMCOM, LLC for operation and management of the Cityride Paratransit Program and Transit Technology Service Program.
