

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 authorizes cities to restrict the parking of vehicles, including but not limited to, vehicles that are six feet or more in height, on identified City streets during certain hours; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4 allows the Council to authorize by resolution, the streets upon which the parking of oversize vehicles shall be restricted between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, an area in Council District 15 is experiencing public safety issues associated with large vehicles that are parked overnight and constrict travel lanes, thereby creating dangerous situations;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council, pursuant to the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4, hereby prohibits the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over 84 inches in height, during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., on both sides of the following streets:

- Frigate Avenue from Pacific Coast Highway to West "L" Street
- West "L" Street from South Figueroa Street to North Wilmington Boulevard
- West Papeete Street from South Figueroa Street to North Wilmington Boulevard
- West Robidoux Street from South Figueroa Street to North Wilmington Boulevard
- West "M" Street from South Figueroa Street to North Wilmington Boulevard
- West Mauretania Street from South Figueroa Street to North Wilmington Boulevard
- Pacific Coast Highway from South Figueroa Street to North Wilmington Boulevard

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the adoption of this Resolution, the Department of Transportation be directed to post signs giving notice of a "tow away, no parking" restriction for oversized vehicles, with the specific hours detailed, at the above streets.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon adoption of this Resolution, that the Department of Transportation be directed to initiate the necessary procedures for the preparation and sale of overnight parking permits, as specified in Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4.(c).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation be authorized to make technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
