

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 authorizes cities to restrict the parking of vehicles, including but not limited to, vehicles that are six feet or more in height, on identified City streets during certain hours; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4 allows the Council to authorize by resolution, the streets upon which the parking of oversize vehicles shall be restricted between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, on January 22, 2016, the Council approved the prohibition of parking for vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over 84 inches in height, during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., on the north roadway of East Lanzit between South Main Street and South Avalon Boulevard (C.F. 16-1203) to address public safety issues associated with the parking of these vehicles; and

WHEREAS, on June 29, 2020, the Los Angeles Police Department sent a letter to the Department of Transportation requesting a "Tow Away, No Stopping Anytime" zone with posted signs and marked red curb on the north roadway of East Lanzit from South Avalon Boulevard to Imperial Highway to address criminal activity and quality of life issues;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council, pursuant to the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4, adopt this Resolution, authorizing the removal of the existing parking prohibition of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over seven feet in height, during the hours of 2:00 am and 6:00 am on North Lanzit Avenue between South Avalon Boulevard and Imperial Highway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation be instructed to simultaneously remove the existing parking restriction signage and install new parking restrictions signs/curb markings to avoid any confusion regarding regulation and enforcement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation be authorized to make technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
