Recommendation for Council action:

APPROVE the exemption of one Service Coordinator position (Class Code 0883) for the BOS from the Civil Service provisions of the City Charter, pursuant to Charter Section 1001(b).

Summary:

On November 2, 2016, your Committee considered an October 24, 2016 communication from the Mayor relative to the exemption of one Service Coordinator position (Class Code 0883) for the BOS from the Civil Service provisions of the City Charter, pursuant to Charter Section 1001(b). According to the Mayor, the Service Coordinator position will be responsible for establishing and maintaining communication with and providing information to the Board of Public Works, City Council, Mayor's Office, Neighborhood Councils and other governmental agencies regarding projects and programs; conferring with BOS management to determine goals, objectives and strategies to be used to coordinate with community groups, Council Offices and the Mayor's Office in development of plans and programs; and coordinating requests from the Mayor's Office with proposed requirements specified by the Council Offices and community groups.

After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the position exemption as detailed in the above recommendation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
