

BUDGET, FINANCE AND INNOVATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to settlement agreement modifications in the case of *Christian Rodriguez, et al. v. City of Los Angeles, et al.* in connection with class member services and related matters.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AMEND and REPLACE Recommendation No. 1 of Motion (Hernandez, McOsker - Price) with:
 - a. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to modify the settlement agreement to extend its term for one year, moving the end date from June 27, 2023 to June 27, 2024, and to modify the settlement agreement to allow class members to sign up for benefits under the settlement agreement until March 27, 2024; and
 - b. INSTRUCT the Economic and Workforce Development Department to report back on a potential successor program to the settlement agreement that could expand the benefits to include services such as childcare, housing/rental/utility assistance, food and other essential living expenses and ensure that these resources are not contingent on work or education path requirements.
2. NOTE and FILE Motion 30A (Hernandez, Soto-Martinez - Harris-Dawson) inasmuch as funding for the program has already been allocated through other means, including the 2023-24 Adopted Budget, and thus the recommendations in this Motion are no longer necessary.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on June 26, 2023, the Budget, Finance and Innovation Committee considered a Recommendation No. 1 of Motion (Hernandez. McOsker – Price) and Motion 30A (Hernandez, Soto-Martinez – Harris-Dawson) relative settlement agreement modifications in the case of *Christian Rodriguez, et al. v. City of Los Angeles, et al.* in connection with class member services and related matters.
