

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the establishment of parking restrictions for oversize vehicles for certain streets in Council District 13.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (O'Farrell - Bonin):

1. RESOLVE, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 80.69.4 and California Vehicle Code Section 22507, to hereby prohibit the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over seven feet in height, during the hours of 2:00 am and 6:00 am, on the following street segments:
 - a. The west side of the 4701-4901 blocks of San Fernando Road between Goodwin Avenue and West Colorado Boulevard.
 - b. Both sides of the 4500-4600 blocks of Colorado Boulevard between San Fernando Road West and the cul-de-sac to the west.
 - c. Both sides of the 4500-4600 blocks of Electronics Place from West San Fernando Road to the cul-de-sac to the west.
 - d. Both sides of the 5300 block of Exchange Street between Sperry Street and Cutter Street.
 - e. Both sides of the 4500 block of Cutter Street between Exchange Street and West San Fernando Road.
 - f. Both sides of the 5400 block of West San Fernando Road between Cutter Street and Doran Street.
 - g. Both sides of the 4500 block of Doran Street between West San Fernando Road and the cul-de-sac to the west.
2. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), upon approval of this action, to post signs giving notice of a Tow Away, No Parking restriction for oversize vehicles on the streets listed above in Recommendation No. 1.
3. DIRECT the LADOT, upon adoption of this Resolution, to initiate the necessary' procedures for the preparation and sale of overnight parking permits, as specified in LAMC Section 80.69.4.(c).
4. AUTHORIZE the LADOT to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On January 25, 2017, your Committee considered a Resolution (O'Farrell - Bonin) relative to the establishment of parking restrictions for oversized vehicles for the following streets in Council District 13:

- a. The west side of the 4701-4901 blocks of San Fernando Road between Goodwin Avenue and West Colorado Boulevard.
- b. Both sides of the 4500-4600 blocks of Colorado Boulevard between San Fernando Road West and the cul-de-sac to the west.
- c. Both sides of the 4500-4600 blocks of Electronics Place from West San Fernando Road to the cul-de-sac to the west.
- d. Both sides of the 5300 block of Exchange Street between Sperry Street and Cutter Street.
- e. Both sides of the 4500 block of Cutter Street between Exchange Street and West San Fernando Road.
- f. Both sides of the 5400 block of West San Fernando Road between Cutter Street and Doran Street.
- g. Both sides of the 4500 block of Doran Street between West San Fernando Road and the cul-de-sac to the west.

An area in Council District 13, adjacent to the I-5 Freeway is experiencing public safety issues related to oversized vehicles parking overnight constricting travel lanes thereby causing dangerous situations.

After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Resolution as detailed in the above recommendations. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
