My name is Greg Romero. I am the Property Supervisor of Hollywood El Centro Apartments. On behalf of Hollywood El Centro Apartments (6211 De Longpre Ave. LA, CA 90028) and Thomas Safran & Associates, I am writing to you regarding the public safety issues in our neighborhood.

On a regular basis, we are experiencing problems related to oversize vehicles that regularly park in our neighborhood. Some of the problems related to the vehicles are trash/debris accumulation, human waste, narcotics paraphernalia, beer bottles, blocking the sidewalks during business hours, public intoxication, unruly behavior, and fights inside the vehicles.



- Leland Way between Vine and Gower
- De Longpre between Vine and Gower
- Afton Place between Vine and Gower
