

MOTION

On September 25, 2018, Council adopted CF 17-0504, which authorized the Mariondale Avenue and Lillyvale Avenue Vacation District (VAC-E1401293) to proceed. Council action is needed to make a technical correction to the previous Council action in order to specify the proper account information for the applicant's deposit as well as to authorize the Controller to accept the funds and deposit them in the proper account.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council's action of September 25, 2018 relative to the Mariondale Avenue and Lillyvale Avenue Vacation District (C.F. 17-0504) be AMENDED to replace recommendation 8(b) with the following:

- Add Condition No. 16 as follows: Deposit \$250,000 with the City for transportation and streetscape improvements on and around Valley Boulevard.

I FURTHER MOVE THAT the Bureau of Engineering be authorized to receive \$250,000 from Grifols, Inc. in order to satisfy the aforementioned condition for transportation and streetscape improvements associated with the vacation.

I FURTHER MOVE THAT the Bureau of Engineering be instructed and authorized to deposit said \$250,000 into Engineering Special Services Fund No. 682, Department No. 50, and appropriate therein to a new account entitled, "Valley Boulevard Multi-Modal Transportation Improvements."

I FURTHER MOVE that BOE be authorized to make technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
