

MOTION

The Bureau of Street Services is currently in the design phase for the Cesar E Chavez Connections Active Transportation Program project. One major component of the project is the closure of a slip lane along Cesar Chavez and the construction of a pedestrian plaza highlighting the journeys and struggles of immigrants to Los Angeles.

The Bureau has designed a plaza that focuses on the story of immigrants to Los Angeles and is an homage to those who have journeyed to the City. Additionally, the Bracero community has been looking to identify funding and a proper location for a statue to tell the story of their journey. Together with the Bureau of Street Services and Department of Cultural Affairs, a location has been identified for a statue at the new plaza. Private funding has been secured for the design and construction of the Bracero statue and the Department of Cultural Affairs is willing to accept the funds in order to secure an artist.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council adopt the following actions:

1. AUTHORIZE the Department of Cultural Affairs to accept the donation from La Plaza Village, LLC. in the amount of \$100,000 and the donation of \$105,000 from Holland Partners in the amount of \$105,000 and deposit these funds (TOTAL: \$205,000) into a new Account in the Cultural Affairs Trust Fund No. 844-30, entitled "Bracero Monument & Cultural Plaza" to be used for the "Bracero Monument & Cultural Plaza," as further described in the text of this Motion;
2. AUTHORIZE the General Manager of the Department of Cultural Affairs or designee to make any technical changes to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
