

MOTION

The Bureau of Sanitation, in addition to curbside collection, also provides collection services to Council Districts involving over 2,500 refuse and recycling receptacles using white wire baskets and Automated Litter Bins placed along the public rights-of-way.

The Bureau executed a sole source contract (C-126377) with Bigbelly Solar, Inc. (Bigbelly) on June 12, 2015 to implement a Council District 1 Smart Waste and Recycling System Pilot Program for one year beginning on September 30, 2015 and ending on September 29, 2016 with an option to renew up to six months on a month-to-month basis with a contract ceiling of \$120,000. On September 28, 2016, the Bureau exercised its option to renew the Bigbelly contract beyond its one year term, because more time was needed to test the system improvements that Bigbelly implemented within the six month contract extension. On March 31, 2017, the Board of Public Works approved the Bureau's request to add another 17 months to the pilot program and increase the contract ceiling to \$385,263.

Action is needed to transfer funding set-aside for the above purpose.

I THEREFORE MOVE that, subject to the approval of the Mayor, \$500,000 be appropriated from the "Clean Streets" line item in the Unappropriated Balance Fund No. 100-58, to the Solid Waste Resources Revenue Fund No. 508-50, Revenue Source Code 530100 to pay for the Council District 1 Smart Waste and Recycling Pilot Program services provided by Bigbelly Solar, Inc. under contract C-126377.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Sanitation, be authorized to make any corrections, clarifications or revisions to the above fund transfer instructions, including any new instructions, in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion, and including any corrections and changes to fund or account numbers; said corrections / clarifications / changes may be made orally, electronically or by any other means.
