

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to an agreement between the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) and the Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) covering the assignment of Hazardous Materials Vehicle No. 12.

Recommendation for Council, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

APPROVE the Letter of Agreement (LOA) between the LAFD and Cal OES which allows for the implementation of the Type II Hazmat Response Vehicle Program for a period of ten years: October 15, 2018 through October 15, 2028.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The Los Angeles Fire Department reports that it received \$86,293.70 used for additional Hazardous Materials Training. There is no impact to the General Fund.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on February 13, 2019, the Public Safety Committee considered a Board of Fire Commissioners transmittal dated December 18, 2018 relative an LOA between the LAFD and Cal OES for the Type II Hazmat Response Vehicle Program for a 10-year period from October 15, 2018 through October 15, 2028.

The LAFD reports that it was selected by Cal OES as one of 12 agencies statewide to receive a Type II Hazmat Response Vehicle (Hazmat Response Vehicle No. 12) and associated equipment. The vehicles are a result of AB 102 that authorized funding to establish Regional Response Teams throughout California in an effort to improve emergency response capabilities to all types of disasters. The LAFD entered a 3-year LOA to implement the Program, however the LAFD is seeking approval of a 10-year LOA that will coincide with the other agreement terms currently in place and will supersede the current 3-year version.

After consideration, and after providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee approved the recommendations in the LAFD report transmitted by the Board of Fire Commissioners. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
