All the streets in Hollywoodland are narrow, winding, substandard streets with a weight limit exclusion for commercial vehicles over 6000 pounds because they are unsafe for larger vehicles. This area is also a very high fire severity zone at elevated risk for wildfire.

Comments for Public Posting: I would like this comment to become part of the public record and part of the deliberations on this proposed ordinance. Many, if not most, streets in the Hollywood Hills were first developed in the 1920s and 1930s, and few have been updated or improved since their original construction. Built to accommodate the few cars that were in use at the time, these streets are now considered substandard by the city, and in a grading system they created, many are labeled "D" or "F." Any such streets that have posted weight limits, whether or not they have not been enforced, should also be included, as overweight vehicles compound the damage to already substandard streets. In addition, many of these streets are in or immediately adjacent to Very High Fire Severity Zones, and sensitive ecological areas. Tour bus traffic on such narrow and substandard streets also has created gridlock situations that made it impossible for emergency vehicles to pass in cases of medical emergency or fire, especially wildfire (when many trucks must enter a neighborhood). The criteria to determine which streets will be prohibited to tour buses of any size must include all such streets. An example is to be found in areas adjacent to Griffith Park, particularly in parts of Lake Hollywood Estates and in all parts of Hollywoodland: Canyon Lake Dr., Mulholland, Durand, DeRonda, Ledgewood, Hollyridge, N. Beachwood, Belden, Rodgerton, Westshire and Woodshire. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
