## AN ORDINANCE ADDING ARTICLE 32 TO DIVISION 5 OF THE LOS ANGELES ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO PROVIDE FOR THE CREATION OF A VICTIM SERVICES TRUST FUND

## Honorable Members:

As requested by the City Council, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance approved as to form and legality. This draft ordinance amends Chapter 5 of Division 5 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code (Administrative Code) in order to create a Victim Services Trust Fund (Fund) within the City Treasury. The purpose of the Fund is the receipt, retention and disbursement of undistributed restitution funds received from the Superior Court and intended to be used to pay for expenses incurred by victims of crimes prosecuted by the City Attorney's Office. Such expense would include, but not be limited to, transportation, parking, child care and lodging. The Fund shall be administered by the City Attorney in accordance with the purposes of the program.

All accrued interest from money deposited into the Fund shall be credited to the Fund. The Fund shall sunset on December 12, 2024. All monies remaining in the Fund shall revert to the Superior Court.
