Consulado General de México en Los Ángeles  
132nd Anniversary

**WHEREAS**, El Consulado General de México en Los Ángeles was established on August 2, 1886 with it's first Consul representative Joaquín Díaz Prieto. During that time, the work of the Consulate was more than anything to facilitate commerce and trade; and

**WHEREAS**, The Consulate was founded after an order was made by the Chamber of Commerce from Los Angeles to Mexico to strengthen commercial ties between both countries; and

**WHEREAS**, The Consulate had its first office in a building located at 132 N. Main St and from there it was relocated a few other times including in 1960 when it moved to the Bizcailuz building in Placita Olvera where it was located for 30 years; and

**WHEREAS**, On September 13, 1989, the Consulate moved to its current and permanent location owned by the Mexican Government located at 2401 West 6th Street, across from MacArthur Park in the Westlake area; and

**WHEREAS**, The Consulate offers a wide variety of documentation services including Mexican passport, Consular registration, voting credentials, birth certificates, marriage certificates, and so much more; and

**WHEREAS**, The Consulate created the "Consulado Sobre Ruedas" service to facilitate and bring documentation services to Mexican nationals closer to their homes taking into account the difficulties that several of them face in traveling to the Consulate office; and


**WHEREAS**, Over the years, the Consulate has made its procedures easier, providing an overall more pleasant experience for all who visit the Consulate; and

**WHEREAS**, The Consulate is a great community partner, supporting, organizing, and leading community initiatives and events of importance to the Mexican and Latino community in Los Angeles; and



Cedric The Entertainer

WHEREAS, Charismatic actor, comedian and producer, Cedric The Entertainer is best known for his crowd-pleasing performances in hit films and television shows such as "Barbershop, "Be Cool" with John Travolta; "Intolerable Cruelty" with George Clooney; "Madagascar" the top-ranking animated franchise; "Johnson Family Vacation," the 2004 box-office hit in which he was both star and producer; and "The Original Kings of Comedy," MTV's mega-successful concert directed by Spike Lee which captured the phenomenon of the record-breaking "Kings of Comedy Tour;" the long-running top-ranked WB sitcom "The Steve Harvey Show;" more recently, for five seasons in his own hit comedy series "The Soul Man" on TV Land; and, now, starring opposite Tracy Morgan and Tiffany Haddish in the acclaimed TBS original dramedy, "The Last OG." In May 2018, "The Neighborhood" was picked up as Cedric's new sitcom on CBS Television in which he will star and also executive produce; and

WHEREAS, On the big screen, the multi-talented funnyman has co-starred alongside some of the most renowned film actors. He was most recently seen in the comedy feature "Why Him?" co-starring opposite Oscar nominated actors Bryan Cranston and James Franco. Cedric has also been seen co-starring with Ice Cube in the No. 1-ranked box office comedy hit "BarberShop: The Next Cut" (2016); "Top Five" (2014); "A Haunted House" (2013) and its sequel "A Haunted House 2" (2014); "Grassroots" (2012); "Larry Crowne" (2011); "All's Faire in Love: Romance Has A Renaissance" (2011); "Cadillac Records" (2008); "Street Kings"(2008); "Welcome Home, Roscoe Jenkins" with Martin Lawrence (2008); "Talk to Me" (2007); "Code Name: The Cleaner" opposite Lucy Liu (2007); "The Honeymooners" (2005); "Man of the House" (2005); "Lemony Snicket's A Series of Unfortunate Events" (2004); "Barbershop 2: Back In Business" (2004); "Serving Sara" (2002); "Kingdom Come" (2001); "Big Momma's House" (2000); and "Ride" (1998); and

WHEREAS, Additionally, Cedric has displayed tremendous voiceover talent in the beloved family features "Disney's Planes" (2013) and its sequel "Disney's Planes: Fire & Rescue" (2014); "Charlotte's Web" (2006); "Madagascar" (2005), and sequels "Madagascar: Escape 2 Africa" (2008), "Madagascar 3: Europe's Most Wanted" (2012), "Ice Age" (2002); and "Dr. Dolittle 2" (2001). Cedric can now be seen taking a dramatic acting turn in the feature film "First Reformed" co-starring opposite Ethan Hawke and Amanda Seyfried, written and directed by Paul Schrader released in May of this year. Past small screen successes include Cedric's much-talked-about Netflix comedy special "Cedric The Entertainer: Live From The Ville" which premiered in 2016 to great audience response; and

WHEREAS, in June 2016, Cedric wrapped the fifth and final season of TV Land's original hit comedy series, "The Soul Man", in which he starred as the quirky and funny Reverend Boyce 'The Voice' Ballentine. The popular show was TV Land's original hit sitcom which Cedric co-created and executive-produced. In 2006, Cedric's first-ever HBO comedy special, "Cedric the Entertainer: Taking You Higher," was the highest-rated special of the year for the network. In 2008, Cedric made his Broadway debut in David Mamet's masterpiece "American Buffalo," where his performance was singled out for critical praise; and

WHEREAS, Cedric was honored with the AFTRA Award of Excellence in Television Programming, the NAACP Image Award for Outstanding Supporting Actor in a Comedy Series, a record-breaking four consecutive NAACP Image Awards for Outstanding Supporting Actor in a Comedy Series, The Richard Pryor Comic of the Year Award from Black Entertainment Television. Helming his own production company, A Bird and A Bear Entertainment, Cedric develops and produces feature films. "Johnson Family Vacation" was the first under this banner. In 2009, he made his directorial debut overseeing the dance-film spoof "Dance Fu," starring comic actor Kel Mitchell; and

WHEREAS, Cedric has joined forces with George Lopez and fellow funnyman D.L. Hughley, Eddie Griffin, (and, previously, the late Charlie Murphy) for "The Comedy Get Down Tour." They have been performing across the country and selling out arenas for the past 4 years now; and

WHEREAS, Cedric founded The Cedric The Entertainer Charitable Foundation, which provides scholarships and outreach programs to enhance the lives of inner-city youth and their families in his hometown of St. Louis, Missouri. The Foundation has awarded hundreds of scholarships and countless incentives. His annual Cedric The Entertainer Celebrity Golf Classic, now in its sixth year is a top charity event which raises funds to benefit: The Kyles Family Foundation, The Brotherhood Crusade of Los Angeles, The Boys & Girls Club of Camarillo, and The American Diabetes Association; and

WHEREAS, Cedric's universal appeal, versatility and tremendous career success spanning film, live performances and television have solidified his standing as one of the premier entertainers in the world; and

WHEREAS, on Thursday, July 19, 2018, Cedric The Entertainer will be immortalized by the Hollywood Chamber of Commerce with the 2,640 star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that by the adoption of this resolution, the Los Angeles City Council does hereby commend and congratulate CEDRIC THE ENTERTAINER on the occasion of being presented with a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame. Niecy Nash

WHEREAS, Niecy Nash was born in Los Angeles. She began her career in the film, *Boys on the Side* starring Whoopi Goldberg. At the time, she had no manager or agent and pushed herself into the audition. It is said that chutzpah and drive is what started her career in show business; and

WHEREAS, Nash is a multi-talented Emmy®-winning producer and twice-nominated actress. Her multifaceted career includes roles in HBO's *Getting On*, which has earned her two Emmy nominations, FOX's *Scream Queens*, Showtime's *Masters of Sex* and TV Land's *The Soul Man*. Nash is also headlining the drama series *Claws* on TNT. The show recently premiered for a second season; and

WHEREAS, Nash was the host and producer of the Style Network's home makeover show, *Clean House*, which became the network's No. 1 program. Her work earned her two Daytime Emmy® nominations, and The American Women in Radio & Television honored Nash with the 2007 Gracie Allen Award for Outstanding Program Host. In addition, Nash was seen regularly as a celebrity panelist on the top-rated entertainment news program *The Insider* on CBS; and

WHEREAS, Nash is well-known for her role as no-nonsense Officer Raineesha Williams on the hilarious Comedy Central hit, *Reno 911!* a half-hour unscripted spoof of *Cops* that aired for six seasons. The show was so popular, it was spun-off into a feature film, *Reno 911: Miami*, in 2007. Nash went on to star in her own FOX comedy series, *Do Not Disturb*, opposite Jerry O'Connell, in 2008; and

WHEREAS, Nash has had featured roles in the films *Guess Who*, opposite Bernie Mac and Ashton Kutcher; *Code Name: The Cleaner*, opposite Cedric the Entertainer and Lucy Liu; *Not Easily Broken*, based on the best-selling book by Bishop T.D. Jakes; and the Walt Disney Pictures summer blockbuster release *G-Force*, produced by Jerry Bruckheimer. Her most recent film credit is for *Downsizing* (directed by Alexander Payne) which opened in January; and

WHEREAS, Nash's television credits are another testament to her talent. Her style, humor and quick wit garnered her a stint as a correspondent on NBC's *The Tonight Show with Jay Leno*. She is also well known for her recurring role on the Peabody Award-winning comedy series *The Bernie Mac Show*, portraying Bernie's uproarious baby sister, Benita. Other recurring roles include TV's *Presidio Med*, *That's Life*, *Popular*, and *City of Angels*. Also included on her resume are guest-starring roles on such top-rated series as *My Name Is Earl*, *Monk*, *CSI: Crime Scene Investigation*, *Girlfriends*, *NYPD Blue*, *That's So Raven*, *One on One*, *Judging Amy* and *Reba*; and

WHEREAS, Nash is currently developing various television and film projects through her own production company, Chocolate Chick, Inc; and

WHEREAS, in her rare spare time, she is devoted to church and participating at charitable functions in support of causes that are close to her heart, including Everytown for Gun Safety, the prevention and awareness of HIV/AIDS, breast cancer, school violence and domestic abuse, among others; and

WHEREAS, on Wednesday, July 11, 2018, Niecy Nash will be immortalized by the Hollywood Chamber of Commerce with the 2,639 star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame:
