WHEREAS, in their three years of operation, the Community Healing Gardens have brought neighbors in the communities they serve together over organic gardening;



**WHEREAS**, Management Analyst Donald Wildy, Serial No. E9975, has completed over 30 years of dedicated law enforcement service for the City of Los Angeles, culminating with his retirement on March 28, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, Management Analyst Donald Wildy, was appointed to the Los Angeles Police Department on June 8, 1988, and has demonstrated outstanding professional conduct in law enforcement in a variety of assignments, including: Training Division as a Detention Officer Recruit; Detention Officer assigned to Hollywood Patrol Division, where he was promoted to Senior Detention Officer; 77<sup>th</sup> Patrol Division where he was appointed to the rank of Principal Detention Officer. Management Aide at Robbery-Homicide Division, where he promoted to the rank of Management Analyst, and assumed the role of Divisional Crime Analyst; and

**WHEREAS**, Management Analyst Donald Wildy, as a member of the Los Angeles Police Department, served the public and provided extraordinary leadership and professionalism during some of the City's most historic events, such as the Pope John Paul II's 1988 visit, the 1992 Civil Unrest, the 1994 Northridge earthquake, the 2000 Democratic National Convention; the 2012 Occupy LA Protest, and lastly, the 2013 manhunt for Christopher Dorner; and

**WHEREAS**, Management Analyst Donald Wildy, known for his outstanding crime analysis skills, assisted in several hundred robbery, kidnapping for ransom, attempt murder of a police officer, human trafficking, and major cases in his illustrious career, and worked on many notable crimes, including several serial robbery cases which resulted in successful jury trial convictions; and

**WHEREAS**, Management Analyst Donald Wildy has received numerous commendations, letters of appreciation, and awards from Chiefs of Police, Commanding Officers, the Federal Bureau of Investigation the Southern California Crime Analyst Association, and grateful citizens. Management Analyst Donald Wildy's 30 years of outstanding achievements exemplify the highest traditions of

the Los Angeles Police Department and has made our City a better and safer place in which to live, work, and visit:
