The Echo Park Neighborhood Council (EPNC) is requesting that the aforesaid CIS be attached to Council File No. 18-0086.

On March 27, 2018, with a quorum of 15, the EPNC Board of Governors held a Brown Act-noticed meeting and with a vote of 15 yeas, 0 nays, and 0 abstentions, the EPNC voted to submit this CIS in support of a Civil and Human Rights ordinance with recommendations.

The Echo Park Neighborhood Council (EPNC) supports the creation of a Civil and Human Rights Ordinance (as mandated under CF 18-0086). We encourage that the following items be taken into account as the City Attorney, Immigrant Affairs and Civil Rights Advocate, and Chief Legislative Analyst begin to develop the ordinance that:

- a. Prohibits discrimination, prejudice, intolerance and bigotry that results in denial of equal treatment of any individual.
 - Include the use of hate speech (as a form of discrimination, prejudice, intolerance and bigotry)
 - Should include "...of any individual and groups of people"
- b. Provides remedies accessible to complainants.
 - Remedies should include civic education before there are complainants
- c. Creates the City of Los Angeles Civil and Human Rights Commission and any other supporting unit to investigate and enforce violations of the proposed Ordinance.
 - Supporting units should have access to professional development and be mandated to monitor and report on all complaints on a regular basis.
