**Honorable Members:**

Pursuant to City Council's request, this Office transmitted, on June 1, 2018, a draft ordinance adding a new Chapter 32 to Division 22 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code establishing a Civil and Human Rights Commission and Executive Director, and a new Article 16 to Chapter IV of the Los Angeles Municipal Code establishing the Los Angeles Civil and Human Rights Ordinance.

After consideration of the matter, the City Council, on November 27, 2018, requested this Office split the transmitted draft into two separate ordinances, and make amendments as specified in the November 1, 2018 communication on file, from the Chair and Vice-Chair of the Immigrant affairs, Civil Rights, and Equity Committee.

Pursuant to that request, we present the enclosed revised draft ordinances, approved as to form and legality, to add a new Chapter 32 to Division 22 of the

Los Angeles Administrative Code establishing a Civil and Human Rights Commission and Executive Director, and a new Article 16 to Chapter IV of the Los Angeles Municipal Code establishing the Los Angeles Civil and Human Rights Ordinance.
