MOTION

I HEREBY MOVE that the Council ADOPT the following recommendations of the City Attorney in order to effect settlement in the case entitled Alisha Emerson v. Los Angeles Police Department, Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. BC572494 (this matter arises from Plaintiff's claims of the following six causes of action under the California's Fair Employment and Housing Act, unless otherwise noted: 1. Disability Discrimination; 2. Disability Discrimination - Failure to Accommodate; 3. Failure to Prevent Discrimination and Harassment; 4. Retaliation; 5. Hostile Work Environment Harassment; and 6. Ralph Act Violation [Civil Code Section 51.7]),
SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to expend up to \$220,000 in settlement of the above-entitled matter.
2. AUTHORIZE the Controller to transfer \$220,000 from the Liability Claims Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009798, Miscellaneous Liability Payouts, to Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009792, Police Liability Payouts.
3. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to draw a demand from Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009792, Police Liability Payouts, in the amount of \$220,000 and made payable to Law Offices of Robin D. Perry; Selik and Associates, APC; and, Alisha Emerson.
4. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney, or designee, to make necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer; and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.
