There is definitely a concern for her safety on her family's part where there was none before. She is not unlike many other Koreans living in the neighborhood, preferring to travel on foot. I understand the location is also very close to several schools and numerous restaurants and retail businesses. Needless to say that there would be significant impact on those surrounding the proposed shelter site.

I love the fact that the area has become very walkable and people can feel free and safe to walk in the area. This, as you know, is not a very common sight to see in the greater LA area. If we are going to encourage a city that promotes walking and community togetherness, it is not the best of ideas to propose a temporary homeless shelter in the middle of a very busy intersection, especially one with the Metro station.

Residents and business owners have not had a chance to make their case and consider alternative sites. This is not a "NIMBY" situation. There hasn't been any public discussions about the location of the shelter, plans do not seem to have been communicated sufficiently and adequately to the residents' satisfaction, and most importantly, the voices of the LA citizens that would be impacted by this decisions have not been heard. The community at this time feel very much marginalized and disrespected, especially during the current political climate sensitive to immigrant issues.

Please reconsider and allow a public debate on alternative sites so that we can make the best decision for the city of Los Angeles together.
