

HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to an agreement with the Salvation Army, and the Right-of-Entry agreement for the property bounded by Hoover Street, South LaFayette Park Place, and Wilshire Boulevard, Lafayette Park Triangle, for temporary bridge housing.

Recommendations for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Department of General Services (GSD), to negotiate and execute the following:

- a. A new three year license agreement with the Salvation Army for the City-owned property bounded by Hoover Street, South LaFayette Park Place, and Wilshire Boulevard (LaFayette Park Triangle), APN 5077-005-901, in Los Angeles CA, 90057 for use as a temporary bridge housing facility.
- b. A new Right of Entry agreement between the GSD, and the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP), for RAP-controlled property bounded by Hoover Street, South LaFayette Park Place, and Wilshire Boulevard (LaFayette Park Triangle), APN 5077-005-901, in Los Angeles CA, 90057 for use as a temporary bridge housing facility.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The Municipal Facilities Committee reports that there is no additional impact to the General Fund for approval of the recommendation in this report. On March 8, 2019, the City Council approved Motion (Wesson - Cedillo) to allocate approximately \$5,481,289 in General City Purposes Fund No. 100/56 and Homeless Emergency Aid Program Grant Fund No. 60P/10, AC-1 - Capital and Operation Support for construction of this facility. This funding is sufficient to cover the cost of construction.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On September 18, 2019, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered the September 9, 2019, Municipal Facilities Committee report relative to the agreement with Salvation Army, and the Right-of-Entry agreement between the GSD and the RAP for RAP-controlled property bounded by Hoover Street, South Lafayette Park Place, and Wilshire Boulevard, Lafayette Park Triangle, in Los Angeles CA, 90057, for use as a temporary bridge housing facility.

A CAO representative provided some background on the matter and responded to questions from the committee members. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation reflected above. The matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
