

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to an offer to dedicate easement for storm drain on the property on the north side of Clarendon Street east of Farralone Avenue (Right-of-Way No. 36000-10080).

Recommendations for Council action:

1. ACCEPT the petitioner's offer to dedicate easement for storm drain on the property on the north side of Clarendon Street east of Farralone Avenue, substantially shown on Exhibit B of the Bureau of Engineering (BOE) report dated May 15, 2018 (attached to the Council file).
2. AUTHORIZE the Board of Public Works to acquire the dedication.
3. INSTRUCT the City Clerk to forward a copy of the Council action of this project, to the Real Estate Division of the BOE for processing.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The BOE reports that a fee of \$3,416.51 was paid for processing this report pursuant to Sections 7.3 and 7.41.1 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code. No additional City funds are needed.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a regular meeting held on October 3, 2018, the Public Safety Committee considered a BOE report regarding an offer to dedicate easement for storm drain on the property on the north side of Clarendon Street east of Farralone Avenue. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended on consent to approve the recommendations in the BOE report. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
