DRAFT ORDINANCE PROVIDES EMPLOYEES IN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES WHO ARE ACTIVATED AS MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL GUARD, NAVAL MILITIA OR ANY RESERVE COMPONENT OF THE ARMED SERVICES OF THE UNITED STATES AS A RESULT OF THE DEPLOYMENT OF MILITARY PERSONNEL IN RESPONSE TO OPERATION ATLANTIC RESOLVE WITH THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THEIR REGULAR CITY SALARIES AND THEIR MILITARY SALARIES AND ENSURES THE CONTINUATION OF CERTAIN BENEFITS FOR THE DURATION OF THEIR MILITARY ASSIGNMENT

This Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. This draft ordinance provides employees in the City of Los Angeles who are activated as members of the National Guard, Naval Militia or any reserve component of the armed services of the United States as a result of the deployment of military personnel in response to Operation Atlantic Resolve, with the difference between their regular City salaries and their military salaries and ensures the continuation of certain benefits for the duration of their military assignment.
