Now that your office has put a halt on evictions in LA County, due to Covid-19, how that will affect me? Will I be receiving a further extension of my tenancy, and if so how long with that allow me to live in my current residence? My income has been greatly reduced due to the Covid-19 Pandemic, my employer had started reducing my hours of work over 3 weeks ago, and I have been laid off from my job temporarily. My loss in income due to Covid-19 has made my financial situation urgent and my housing situation very uncertain. I would like to request an additional 1 year extension of my tenancy, and for all those who have a mandatory relocation under the Ellis Act.
