

COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR, PERSONNEL AND ANIMAL WELFARE COMMITTEE relative to the exemption of one Senior Project Coordinator (Class Code 1538) position for the Library Department from the Civil Service provisions of the City Charter.

Recommendation for Council action:

APPROVE the exemption of one Senior Project Coordinator (Class Code 1538) position for the Library Department from the Civil Service provisions of the City Charter pursuant to Charter Section 1001(b).

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Mayor. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Summary:

On November 21, 2018, the Chair of the Personnel and Animal Welfare Committee considered a November 13, 2018 communication from the Mayor relative to the exemption of one Senior Project Coordinator (Class Code 1538) position for the Library Department from the Civil Service provisions of the City Charter pursuant to Charter Section 1001(b). According to the Mayor, Charter Section 1001(b) allows up to 150 persons to be exempt, of which 142 are approved. There are an additional 50 exempt positions added by the City Council pursuant to Charter Section 1001 (b)(4), of which 15 are filled. Approval of this request will increase the count. As of November 13, 2018, the date of the communication from the Mayor, this request will be in the 148th position of the 150 exemptions. This position was funded in the budget for Fiscal Year 2018-19. The Senior Project Coordinator position will manage the Volunteer LA program and volunteer engagement in the Los Angeles Public Library's Office of Volunteer Engagement. After consideration, the Committee Chair moved to recommend approval of the exemption as detailed in the above recommendation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
