Council President Nury Martinez,

We face evictions, homelessness, and rising rents. LA has an affordable housing crisis. The proposed Vacation Rental Ordinance would make it much worse by allowing the ultra-wealthy buy second homes and then list them as vacation rentals instead of housing. That would cost Los Angeles an estimated 14,740 housing units.

I urge you to reject the Vacation Rental Ordinance, Council File Number: 18-1246, which would allow second homes to be used as short-term rentals and listed on platforms like Airbnb and VRBO. We need more aggressive enforcement of the current home-sharing ordinance, not more loopholes that convert affordable housing into illegal hotels in our neighborhoods.

We also need to stop Hedge Funds and investment groups from buying up single home units and shutting normal people out of the housing market. We need to make these predatory buying practices illegal, as well as not allowing Foreign investment groups to buy up residential properties.

We need to stop the creation of high rise apartments (over three stories) and get back to single story small village type housing units, such as Los Angeles originally had. As well as tiny housing villages for the homeless. Not the cruddy ones currently being built, but nice ones as in Washington, or small monolithic done units.
