

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding any administrative or legislative action which would prohibit the practice of industrial clear-cutting in the forests of California, and would require forest management methods that maximize carbon sequestration and forest health.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Koretz- Blumenfield), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2019-20 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for any administrative or legislative action which would prohibit the practice of industrial clear-cutting in the forests of California, and would require forest management methods that maximize carbon sequestration and forest health.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the Chief Legislative Analyst nor the City Administrative Officer has completed a financial analysis of this report.


Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on February 7, 2020, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a Resolution (Koretz - Blumenfield) relative to including in the City's 2019-20 State Legislative program support for any administrative or legislative action which would prohibit the practice of industrial clear-cutting in the forests of California, and would require forest management methods that maximize carbon sequestration and forest health. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to Council for its consideration.
