Summary: We support Council File #19-0002-S50, which opposes California State Assembly Bill #506 (AB 516). The restrictions proposed in AB 516 seek to limit current authority of local law enforcement to have vehicles removed from the public-right-of-way and impounded under specific circumstances: vehicles that have five or more unpaid parking citations, registration that is six months or more out of date, or have been left on a public street for over 72 hours without being moved. We agree that imposing these restrictions would remove a critical law enforcement tool.
