Summary: At the October 26, 2022 Encino Neighborhood Council's (ENC) regular board meeting, under quorum, we discussed and voted to support a recommendation regarding encampments in high-fire areas. The ENC recommends that the City Council, Mayor's Office, and Fire Marshall request amendment of Ordinance 186294 to expand application to all areas with extreme fire potential that are not in Very High Fire Severity Hazard Zones (e.g. Sepulveda Basin). We further request to institute an immediate "zero tolerance" policy for any encampments or noticed trespassing in such areas as determined by the LAFD Valley Bureau Commander or designee, subject to criminal trespassing sanctions and immediate removal of persons and any materials deposited in the area by appropriate outreach and sanitation personnel. All actions should reference the ordinance and CF 19-0050.
