Subject: **ESTABLISHMENT OF SALARY FOR NEW CLASS - DIRECTOR OF AUTOMATED PEOPLE MOVER SYSTEMS (CLASS CODE 7266)**

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that:

1. The City Council, subject to approval by the Mayor, adopt the accompanying ordinance, approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, amending Schedule "A" of Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 4.61 to establish the salary for the new, non-represented classification of Director of Automated People Mover Systems;
2. The City Council authorize the City Administrative Officer (CAO), upon accretion of said classes to a bargaining unit, to amend the appropriate Memorandum of Understanding to reflect the salary approved by ordinance;
3. The City Council authorize the CAO and the Controller to correct any clerical errors or technical errors in the Ordinance.

SUMMARY

At its meeting on November 29, 2018, the Board of Civil Service Commissioners approved the creation of the new classification of Director of Automated People Mover Systems. Subsequently, on February 8, 2019, the Executive Employee Relations Committee approved the recommendations of the CAO to establish the salary for the new class as follows:

Class Code	New Classification	Salary Range	Annual Salary
7266	Director of Automated People Mover Systems	8047	\$168,021 - \$245,653

Accordingly, the ordinance transmitted herewith adds Director of Automated People Mover Systems (Class Code 7266) at Salary Range 8047 to the City's classification listing in Schedule "A" of Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 4.61.

FISCAL IMPACT

This position is exclusive to Los Angeles World Airports and the associated cost will not impact the General Fund.
