The Echo Park Neighborhood Council (EPNC) supports the Neighborhood Councils Budget Advocates recommendation that the Mayor present his proposed Budget on February 1, 80 days earlier than the L.A. City Charter mandated date of April 20.

EPNC supports the Neighborhood Councils Budget Advocates recommendation in the development of the City's Budget and Finances since it must be an open and transparent process where all interested parties, including Budget Advocates, have ample time to review, analyze, and comment. There is not sufficient time under the current mandated date of April 20th.

Board Resolution

On December 17, 2019, the EPNC Board of Governors held a Brown Act noticed-meeting at Echo Park United Methodist Church, 1226 Alvarado St., L.A. CA 90026 at 7:00 p.m. With a quorum of 19 Board members present and a vote count of 17 yeas, 0 nays, and 2 abstentions, the Board resolved to write a letter in support of the new deadline.
