

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to expanding Fire District 1 to include all areas within the City covered by the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection's Very High Severity Zone and the City's High Wind Velocity Zone, including high density population centers.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. REQUEST the City Attorney, with the assistance of Los Angeles Department of Building and Safety (LADBS), Department of City Planning (DCP), and Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD), to draft an ordinance expanding Fire District 1 to Regional Center Land Use designations and Height Districts 2, 3 and 4 Parcels.
2. AUTHORIZE LADBS, LAFD and DCP to make any technical corrections or amendment needed to ensure that boundaries of these areas are clear and cohesive.

At a regular meeting held on June 2, 2021 the Public Safety Department virtually considered a LADBS report in collaboration with the LAFD and the Los Angeles Housing and Community Investment Department relative to expanding Fire District 1, California Department of Forestry, Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone and City High Wind Velocity Zone. After providing an opportunity for public comment the Chair made verbal recommendations for department actions. The Committee approved the recommendations as amended read by the Chair, as detailed above. This matter is now transmitted to the Planning and Land Use Management Committee for its approval.
