On June 20th, 2019 the Board of Harbor Commissioners acted to deny an appeal on Coastal Development Permit No. 18-25, thereby authorizing the installation of landside infrastructure necessary to operate automated, driverless trucks at APM Terminals on Pier 400 at the Port of Los Angeles

The potential consequences of this action are substantial and the Board should be provided with the opportunity to reconsider the appeal and make a deliberative decision. Action is needed to assert jurisdiction over this matter so that Council can veto the effective action of the Board of Harbor Commissioners and send it back to the Board for further review.

I THEREFORE MOVE that pursuant to section 245 of the Los Angeles City Charter, the City Council assert jurisdiction over the Board of Harbor Commissioners June 20th, 2019 action to deny an appeal on Coastal Development Permit No. 18-25.

I FURTHER MOVE that upon assertion of jurisdiction, the Council veto the action of the Board of Harbor Commissioners and remand the matter back to the Board.


