

PLANNING AND LAND USE MANAGEMENT (PLUM) COMMITTEE REPORT relative to amending Section 12.03 and adding Section 11.5.15 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to define and prohibit the uses of Private Detention Center and Community Detention Facility for Unaccompanied Minors citywide.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. ADOPT the language in the proposed Ordinance recommended by the Department of City Planning (DCP) to the Los Angeles City Planning Commission (LACPC) in the DCP Staff Recommendation Report dated December 10, 2020, attached to the Council file, in lieu of the language in the LACPC's Letter of Determination dated December 15, 2020, inasmuch as it is consistent with the request of the Council.
2. REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present an Ordinance amending Section 12.03 and adding Section 11.5.15 to Chapter I of the LAMC, to define and prohibit the uses of Community Detention Facility for Unaccompanied Minors and Private Detention Center to align with State of California law (Penal Code Section 9500 et seq.).
3. INSTRUCT the DCP to prepare a report with recommendations and an analysis of the language recommended by the LACPC, including an analysis of the range of additional uses that might be captured or impacted.

Summary:

At a special meeting held on April 15, 2021, the PLUM Committee considered reports from the LACPC and DCP, and a proposed Ordinance relative to amending LAMC Section 12.03, and adding Section 11.5.15 to Chapter I of the LAMC, to define and prohibit the uses of Community Detention Facility for Unaccompanied Minors and Private Detention Center citywide. A Representative of Council District 6 provided comments regarding the proposed Ordinance. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the

Committee recommended to adopt the language in the proposed Ordinance recommended to the LACPC in the DCP Staff Recommendation Report dated December 10, 2021; requested that the City Attorney prepare and present the Ordinance with said language; and, instructed the DCP to prepare a report with recommendations and an analysis of the language recommended by the LACPC, including an analysis of the range of additional uses that might be captured or impacted. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
