Comments for Public Posting: Dear Council Members: As an individual that provides free medical care to the homeless, I support housing for the homeless. However I am only in favor of the project if there is a balance of rights for those individuals housed at the Figueroa site and those property owners in the area. I have been a resident of Eagle Rock for 7 years. I currently live near Eagle Vista and Waldo Place, about a quarter mile from the proposed shelter site. After 6 quiet years in this neighborhood, I have unfortunately had three negative incidents with homeless individuals currently residing on this lot. The first was a theft of property, that the individual was identified via camera footage. The second is where a crowbar and various other tools were found on my property in front of my door, where a potential break-in was likely interrupted by neighbors. The third, again was a trespassing on my property, with materials left behind that were confirmed by police to belong to individuals in this encampment. I fear that if 24 hour security is not provided at this proposed shelter development, that I and my neighbors will have to continue to experience increased fear of crime in our neighborhood. For years, I used to run Figueroa daily. I no longer can do so due to fears for my safety, both physically and due to the trash, needles, and other items I care not to mention that litter the gutters and sidewalks. This proposed site must come with assurances that those individuals that live in the neighborhood, maintain their rights to a safe and clean neighborhood, by the provision of security and resources to supervise and assist the tenants of this proposed shelter 24 hours a day/7 days a week. Should you be able to ensure this, then as a person who lives within a quarter mile of this proposed project, I support it. Without these assurances, I strongly oppose. Thank you.
