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Comments for Public Posting: I am a resident of Eagle Rock and was made aware that temporary shed shelters are to be placed in a parking lot across the street from Eagle Rock Park. While I am in support of finding better solutions for the homeless in Los Angeles, creating temporary shelters without concerns for the nearby residents feels like a bandaid especially since Eagle Rock already struggles with harassment and attacks from the homeless population. I personally was assaulted by a homeless woman two blocks from my home in February of 2021 and was told by the police that nothing could be done about it even though this same woman has been attacking multiple other community members and even featured on the local news. She continues to roam the streets of Eagle Rock assaulting other women. If a temporary homeless shelter is to be created in this located, which is hundreds of feet away from schools and local residents, how is the city going to protect the people living here? What is being done to make sure that this community is safe? Furthermore, what is being done to ensure that these shelters are temporary and not a situation in which it becomes long-term housing because there are no better permanent solutions?
