Subject: **TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS FOR THE 2018-2021 MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR THE EQUIPMENT OPERATION AND LABOR EMPLOYEES REPRESENTATION UNIT (MOU 4) (C.F. NO. 19-0845)**

The 2018-2021 Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City of Los Angeles and the Service Employees International Union (SEIU), Local 721, for the Equipment Operation and Labor Employees Representation Unit (MOU 4) contains the following technical errors that require correction:

APPENDICES A - F

The class codes for Boat Captain I - Harbor and Boat Captain II - Harbor were inadvertently listed incorrectly in the Appendices of the MOU. Correct the class codes as follows:

DELETE CLASS CODE	ADD CLASS CODE
5113 - 1H	5113 - 3
5113 - 2H	5113 - 4

Class title, salary range, starting and maximum compensation shall remain unchanged.

Include the new trainee classification of Vocational Worker Animal Care Technician, Class Code 3113-B to the following Appendices. These changes will require a revision to the alphabetical order of the Salary Appendices.
