Summary:


On August 21, 2019, your Committee considered a July 31, 2019 GSD report relative to the exemption of four positions for the GSD/Construction Services Division (CFD) from the Civil Service provisions of the City Charter. Specifically, the exemption request is for the following positions:

1	Construction Estimator	3341
1	Construction and Maintenance Supervisor II	3127-2
2	Electrical Craft Helper	3799

According to the GSD, the CFD is being requested to provide expedited and fast track construction services to support the Mayor's residential projects for reducing homelessness. The CFD can meet this requirement but it requires dedicated staffing. The GSD is requesting the positions indicated to expedite the construction of temporary shelters including hygiene facilities in order to achieve the Mayor's homelessness reduction goals. The project will require the staffing resources the division does not currently possess. The staffing will be dedicated to projects related to construction of temporary shelters for the homeless. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the exemption request as detailed in the GSD and the above recommendation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
