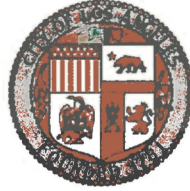

**FISCAL YEAR 2019-20 ANNUAL COST OF SPECIAL SERVICES FEE ADJUSTMENTS  
(C.F. 19-0956) [CORRECTED]**

Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 57.115 authorizes the Board of Fire Commissioners, with concurrence of the City Administrative Officer (CAO), to modify fees based on the total cost of special services. On August 20, 2019, the Board of Fire Commissioners approved the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) report and recommendations to modify the fees (Attachments to the report as "Proposed Fee Schedule" and "Resolution") that had been concurred by the CAO. The report was transmitted to City Council for consideration, and on September 25, 2019, the Public Safety Committee moved to recommend approval of the fee adjustments as detailed in the Board report (C.F. 19-0956).

Subsequent to the Public Safety Committee's action, the LAFD noted two references to the LAMC requiring corrections as specified below. There are no corrections to the respective proposed permit fees.

- A.) Operational Permit Fees (LAMC 57.113.6)  
Day Care Occupancy/Large Family Daycare  
From: 13-14 children  
Corrected to: 9-14 children
  
- B.) Specific Action or Project Permits Fees (LAMC 57.105.7.8)  
Use of Tent or Membrane Structure as a Place of Assemblage  
From: 450 to 3,500 square feet  
Corrected to: 401 to 3,500 square feet

The above corrections have been made to Attachment 1, Proposed Fee Schedule and Attachment 2, Resolution, which are transmitted to the City Council for its consideration and approval.
