Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Bonin - Blumenfield):

INSTRUCT the Department of General Services (GSD), with the assistance of the City Attorney and any other relevant departments, to negotiate a lease agreement, or other appropriate agreement, with Verizon Wireless for space at the Hyperion Water Treatment Plant, located at 12000 Vista Del Mar, Playa Del Rey, 90293 in Council District 11, to install rooftop antennas and equipment cabinets.
