

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the monetary donation of \$17,765.67 from the Los Angeles Police Foundation (LAPF) to fund equipment to enhance the Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) Sniper Weapon Systems for the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) Metropolitan Division.

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the monetary donation of \$17,765.67 from the LAPF to fund equipment to enhance the SWAT Sniper Weapon Systems for the LAPD Metropolitan Division, SWAT team; and, THANK the donor for this generous donation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners (Board). Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On October 23, 2019, your Committee considered a September 3, 2019 Board report relative to monetary donation of \$17,765.67 from the LAPF to fund equipment to enhance the SWAT Sniper Weapon Systems for the LAPD Metropolitan Division, SWAT team. According to the Board, upon approval, the funds will be used to pay for equipment to enhance SWAT's sniper weapon system currently used by the sniper cadre. The equipment will provide the SWAT the means to facilitate advanced training and enhance effectiveness during high-risk missions. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of accepting the donation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
