Fiscal Impact Statement: Not applicable.

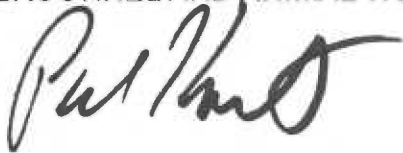
Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On January 15, 2020, your Committee considered a December 27, 2019 BOS report relative to policy and procedure for scanning for a microchip when picking up a dead animal and notifying the registered owner. According to the BOS, it is responsible for the Dead Animal Removal from City streets, alleys, vacant lots, etc. within the City boundaries. BOS staff will make every attempt to scan every animal retrieved to determine if a microchip is present. Also, the BOS will make every attempt to recover any identifiable tags attached to a collar that may be still present. The BOS then provided an overview of the specific policy and answered questions from the Committee members. After further consideration, the Committee moved to note and file the BOS report. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
