

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of \$25,000 from the Hollywood Museum to fund the Hollywood Area Holiday Party.

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the donation of \$25,000 from the Hollywood Museum to fund the Hollywood Area Holiday Party.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners (Board). Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On January 22, 2020, your Committee considered an October 17, 2019 Board report relative to the donation of \$25,000 from the Hollywood Museum to fund the Hollywood Area Holiday Party. According to the Board, the donation is for the benefit of Hollywood Area's personnel to enjoy an evening of camaraderie at their annual holiday party. Ms. Donelle Dadigan is a private citizen who offered her assistance to Hollywood Division, which was not solicited by Hollywood Area. Ms. Dadigan has not entered into, performs under, or seeks a contract with the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD); has not attempted to influence the Department in the past year that would have a direct effect on Hollywood Area. Ms. Dadigan does not have any licenses, permits or other entitlements for use that the LAPD has influence over; does own and operate a business (The Hollywood Museum) within Hollywood Area; and, to our knowledge, there are no other potential factors that may give the appearance that there may be a conflict of interest in accepting this donation. The Donor has been vetted by Hollywood Area and no expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any LAPD patents. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of accepting the donation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
